Getting to Marzabotto / Accommodation

The closest airport is **Bologna Airport**. Once landed, you can get the Bus to Bologna Train Station (via services easily accessible from the airport, such as the bus shuttle **Bus&Fly** or the **Marconi Express**) and then a 32-min train to Marzabotto.

There is no available accommodation directly in Marzabotto, the closest locations are Sasso Marconi and Bologna.


